Synopsis

Once Upon a High School by Flip Kobler and Cindy Marcus is a comedy about what might happen if some of our favorite fairy-tale characters magically arrived in a present-day high school. The definitions of fantasy and reality are challenged and questioned, as the audience and some of the characters are granted a glimpse into the daily routines of two different worlds. When the status-quo is contested because of the intruders, the fairy-tale characters and the high school students must redefine their own realities.

The Woodsman and Danica (and the characters in both universes) lose their negative perceptions of life when they gain hope in their capacity to create futures filled with wonder and magic. All of the characters recognize that they can indeed be the heroes of their own stories. There are no *incidentals*!

Scenes

Act 1

- Scene 1: Classroom in fairytale land, once upon a time
- Scene 2: After school that day in the classroom
- Scene 3: High school hallway near janitor's closet in reality, one Friday morning
- Scene 4: Fairytale classroom, after school that day
- Scene 5: High school hallway, still that Friday
- Scene 6: Fairytale classroom, a couple days later in fairytale time
- Scene 7: High school hallway, still Friday

Act 2

- Scene 1: High school hallway, immediately following
- Scene 2: High school principal's office, immediately following
- Scene 3: Fairytale classroom, another new day
- Scene 4: High school detention office, still Friday afternoon
- Scene 5: High school hallway, the same
- Scene 6: Fairytale classroom, later that day
- Scene 7: High school hallway near janitor's closet, later Friday
- Scene 8: High school dance, Friday night
- Scene 9: Hallway with janitor's closet, then split stage with fairytale and reality

Notes

When I first read this play, *Once Upon a High School* by Flip Kobler and Cindy Marcus, I was entranced. The Woodsman needs to be a hero and Danica needs to believe in magic. Along the way, these two characters are transformed, and they manage to alter the lives of the real world and fairy-tale characters they encounter. After my initial reading, I reflected upon the themes presented in this play. Realizing that life is truly about transformations, beliefs, recognizing possibilities, and the ripple effect we have on others, I knew this was the drama production choice for this particular year. We hope you are entranced as well.
